Covid Protocols

REVISED FEBRUARY 6, 2023

Below is an outline of CELP's current policies in place to follow protocols. Please note these processes are subject to change based on the LA County Department of Public Health and the California Dept. of Health.

Covid-19 Screening and Testing

- * School group conducts in-person entry screening of all attendees within 24 hours prior to boarding the Catalina Express to travel to the Island.
- * School Group collects proof of a negative Rapid Antigen Covid-19 test for all guests enrolled in program with in 24 hours prior to the boat departure.
- * School collects screening information of all participants and signs off upon arrival to CELP that preventative measures have been taken to ensure attendees are healthy.
- * **Any student or chaperone who tests positive for COVID-19, has symptoms consistent with COVID-19 infection cannot attend camp.**

Masks:

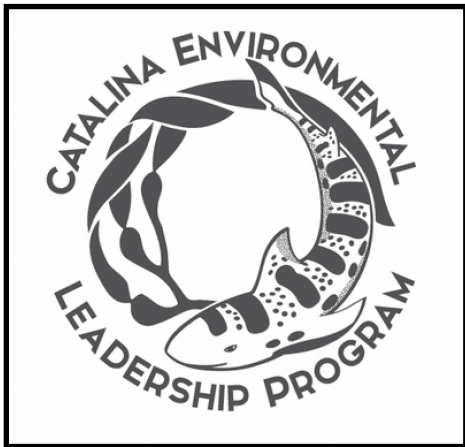
- * Masks are NOT required to wear at camp.
- * Anyone is welcome to use a mask while at camp.

Staff:

- * All staff members on site are vaccinated
- * All staff members complete weekly Antigen testing
- * All food served to attendees by staff members wearing PPE

Illness & Exposure Management:

- * Rapid testing available on site for individuals who develop symptoms while at CELP
- * **Should an attendee test positive for Covid-19, they will need to depart on the next ferry home.**

SUGGESTED DAY OF DEPARTURE HEALTH SCREENING QUESTIONS

* Do you have any symptoms consistent with Covid- 19 (I.e. fever/chills, cough, sore throat, body aches, or shortness of breath)?

* Is anyone in your household currently infected with Covid-19?

SCHOOL CERTIFICATION OF SCREENING

A designated school representative must certify that the school has screened all guests attending CELP on the day of departure, and that no one has Covid-19 Symptoms and has tested negative on a rapid antigen test the day of departure.
